Get a head start in your studies and secure University credits while in High School

Griffith Eng is a part-time university course for Year 12 students through our Head Start program. This program offers an opportunity to gain university experience and credit while you finish high school.

Improved selection rank

As part of the Year 12 Subject Adjustment Scheme, students who pass Griffith Eng will be eligible to receive two (2.00) adjustments towards their selection rank when applying for entry into an eligible Griffith undergraduate degree.

QCE recognition

Queensland students will have their enrolment and grades recorded on their Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) as two credits of advanced courses of study. This does not count towards their ATAR calculation.

Earn degree credits early

Obtaining credit will allow you to reduce your university workload and fees when you start uni. Students who pass the course will be eligible to receive 10 credit points for the equivalent course in a range of undergraduate engineering degrees.

Make it matter

Attendance

Griffith Eng is offered in the first half of Year 12 (March–May 2025). Students will attend weekly workshops on campus and work together on a group project. Students will complete a series of presentations and submit a final portfolio at the end of the course.

Course content

Students will be introduced to the engineering design process and professional aspects of being an engineer.

They will collaborate in teams to develop solutions for real-world challenges, taking into account the complex interactions among engineering systems, project stakeholders, and the environment.

Students who successfully complete the course will earn full credit for Engineering Design Practice (1022ENG).

Course fees

Griffith ENG is free for students, with Griffith University covering your tuition fees. This will help lower the overall cost of your undergraduate degree at Griffith.

Admission criteria

To apply for Griffith Eng (1000ENG), students will need to:

- Complete our online application and provide your most recent school report
- Obtain approval from your principal, guidance officer or careers adviser and provide a completed Principal Approval form.

For admission students must be:

- Achieve a minimum grade of C (or equivalent passing grade) in Mathematical Methods (or equivalent subject) plus one of Chemistry, Engineering, Specialist Mathematics or Physics (or equivalent subject)
- ATAR or Diploma of the International Baccalaureate (IB) eligible or meeting one of the non-ATAR or non-standard eligibility criteria, as listed at griffith.edu.au/head-start-at-school
