MASTERS DEGREE (COURSEWORK)

PURPOSE

The Masters Degree (Coursework) qualifies individuals who apply an advanced body of knowledge in a range of contexts for professional practice or scholarship and as a pathway for further learning

KNOWLEDGE

- Graduates of a Masters Degree (Coursework) will have:
- a body of knowledge that includes the understanding of recent developments in a discipline and/or area of professional practice
- knowledge of research principles and methods applicable to a field of work and or learning

SKILLS

Graduates of a Masters Degree (Coursework) will have:

- cognitive skills to demonstrate mastery of theoretical knowledge and to reflect critically on theory and professional practice or scholarship
- cognitive, technical and creative skills to investigate, analyse and synthesise complex information, problems, concepts and theories and to apply established theories to different bodies of knowledge or practice
- cognitive, technical and creative skills to generate and evaluate complex ideas and concepts at an abstract level
- communication and technical research skills to justify and interpret theoretical propositions, methodologies, conclusions and professional decisions to specialist and non-specialist audiences
- technical and communication skills to design, evaluate, implement, analyse and theorise about developments that contribute to professional practice or scholarship

Graduates of the Master of Cinematic Arts will have:

1. Specialist knowledge and skills associated with recent developments in the screen industries as well as screen practice as research method.

Graduates of the Master of Cinematic Arts will be able to:

- Create and evaluate substantial, industry-focused and research-informed screen projects that address contemporary market needs and convey complex ideas to diverse audiences.
- 2. Collaborate and communicate effectively with a high level of personal autonomy and accountability as a practitioner within the local, national and international screen industries.
- Demonstrate creativity, initiative, and entrepreneurial skills to establish sustainable career paths and thrive in a rapidly changing global screen industry.
- 4. Embrace community impact through authentic engagement, strong professional ethics and sustainable screen production practices.
- Reflect critically on their own cultural and professional values, while actively
 engaging as a global citizen in diverse cultural and professional contexts, with an
 awareness of Indigenous knowledge systems.
